MAJOR POINTS OF DISCUSSION:

1. Two new memberships were approved. We welcome Rachana Puri and her daughters Priyanka Puri and Pranathi Puri and Amol Janorkar and his daughter Sanika.
2. The president mentioned currently only the treasurer's name is on the JPS bank account. In the past, the president along with the treasurer had access to the account. It is important that a second person should have access to the account, so the bank will not cease the account in case of eventuality. Eckhard requested permission from the membership to have his name added to the account. Membership approved the request and a letter to the bank was signed by the JPS officers.
3. KR asked if there is any payment involved to the bank. Rachana Puri mentioned both people on the bank account should have independent access.
4. Eckhard reminded the membership that several renewals for 2023 are past due and that anyone who did not pay by March 31 will be removed from the roster.
5. Karl announced he made a deposit of \$43.-that includes memberships and auction money. The initial balance of \$3974.92 is brought up to a current total of \$4017.92 first time ever to cross 4000.-
6. The Gulf Coast Stamp Club's annual show will be held from March 31 to April 1 from 10 AM to 6PM Friday and 10 to 4pm on Saturday.
7. The next meeting will be held on March 18, 2023 at 10 AM.
8. At 10:30 AM KR took the stage with his presentation about how to collect, sort, arrange stamps in albums. Included the technic of stamp collecting for 45 minutes as a starting point for new members and reconfirmation for the existing members.
9. Auction started at 11:30 am and meeting was finished at 12:10 PM.
