At the August Monthly Meeting of JPS, Harini Vedala presented the topic – “WOMEN IN STAMPS”.

Women played an important role in several roles in society and some of the women were recognized through stamps from several countries. In 1893 Queen Isabella of Spain was issued for 400th anniversary.

First lady Martha Washington stamp was issued in 1902, 1938 by US. In 1936 the US issued stamps on Eleanor Roosevelt and on Susan Anthony for 16th anniversary of 19th amendment.

African women started an association for color people and in 1990 a stamp was issued -- women for equality.

A US stamp was issued for arts and literature - Mary Cosart from Pennsylvania.

Stamp was issued for Margare Higgins Sanger, a journalist first woman to get Pulitzer Prize

In 1952 stamp was issued by armed forces honoring women in army -for Lady Death from Russia. Europe issued a stamp for Madam Curie.

Romania issued for Mother Teresa service for humanity. Central Africa issued stamp for women wearing traditional dresses to maintain cultural tradition.

First woman stamp was issued for Meera Bai the queen and devotee of Lord Krishna by India in 1952. India has issued stamps on several women like Indira Gandhi, Kasturba

Gandhi, Mother Teresa, air hostess Neeraja Vinod who fought with tourists, Audrey Hepburn, actress Madhu Bala, and Marylinn Monroe. Several other countries like Australia also issued stamps commemorating women. The presentation was informative and interesting.

Since there were few members there was no formal auction but some members in attendance purchased their selections.

The presentation was interesting and informative. The meeting was adjourned at 11: 30 AM.
